I write to confirm that, as Convener of the Top Level Group on Multilateral Nuclear Disarmament and Non-Proliferation (TLG), I have worked with you and the TalkWorks' films initiative over the last eighteen months, and to provide you with a letter of endorsement and recommendation, based on that experience.
